GEORGE W. BUSH PRESIDENTIAL CENTER

Located on the SMU campus in Dallas, Texas, the George W. Bush Presidential Center is a nonpartisan institution advancing the timeless values of freedom, opportunity, accountability, and compassion. The Bush Center comprises the George W. Bush Presidential Museum and the George W. Bush Institute, a solution-oriented policy organization focused on ensuring opportunity for all, strengthening democracy, and advancing free societies through policy solutions and public engagement. The Bush Center also houses the George W. Bush Presidential Library, operated by the National Archives and Records Administration, which provides access to official documents and artifacts from the George W. Bush Administration.

GEORGE W. BUSH PRESIDENTIAL MUSEUM

The Bush Museum promotes a greater understanding of the American presidency and examines the consequential times during which President and Mrs. Bush served. The Boeing Company Exhibition Gallery features a moving

exhibit on September 11, 2001, a replica Oval Office, and Decision Points presented by Steve & Amy Van Andel, an interactive experience in presidential decision-making.

The Bradford M. Freeman Exhibition Gallery hosts a variety of special exhibits that delve into unique topics and provide insights that only a presidential center can offer. Past special exhibits have included President Bush's paintings of veterans and immigrants, a look at humor in the White House, America's first ladies, the advance of freedom, and more.


