GEORGE W. BUSH PRESIDENTIAL CENTER

Located on the SMU campus in Dallas, Texas, the George W. Bush Presidential Center is a nonpartisan institution advancing the timeless values of freedom, opportunity, accountability, and compassion. The Bush Center comprises the George W. Bush Presidential Museum and the George W. Bush Institute, a solution-oriented policy organization focused on ensuring opportunity for all, strengthening democracy, and advancing free societies through policy solutions and public engagement. The Bush Center also houses the George W. Bush Presidential Library, operated by the National Archives and Records Administration, which provides access to official documents and artifacts from the George W. Bush Administration.

GEORGE W. BUSH PRESIDENTIAL MUSEUM

The Bush Museum promotes a greater understanding of the American presidency and examines the consequential times during which President and Mrs. Bush served. The museum offers a moving exhibit on September II, 200I, a replica Oval Office, and an interactive experience in presidential decision-making.

The Bradford M. Freeman Exhibition Gallery hosts a variety of annual special exhibitions that delve deeply into unique topics and provide insights that only a presidential center can offer. Past special exhibits have included President Bush's paintings of veterans and immigrants, a look at humor in the White House, American presidents' relationship with baseball and its personification of the Nation's social struggles, and more.

In addition to daytime plenary sessions, President and Mrs. Bush honor courageous leaders with the George W. Bush Medal for Distinguished Leadership, the George W. Bush Institute Citation, and the George W. Bush Institute Trailblazer Citation. This spring event regularly attracts national and global media attention such as CNN, *The New York Times*, *Político*, FOX News, and the Associated Press, and has a broad reach through social media.
